

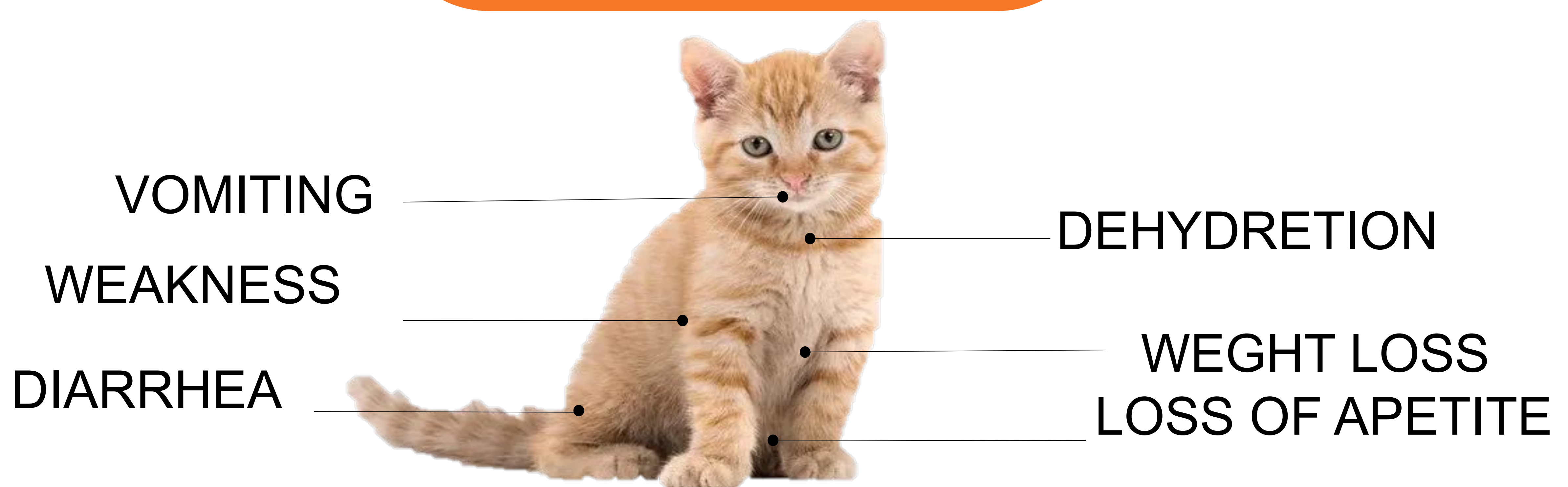
# Parvo in Cat

## what is virus parvo ?

Parvovirus in cats is also known as feline distemper and It is sometimes referred to as panleukopenia virus because one of the results of infection is the development of a low white blood cell count (which is what panleukopenia means). This condition is the most common and severe in unvaccinated and cats kittens that are 2 to 6 months old. In addition, the virus is not contagious to humans.
